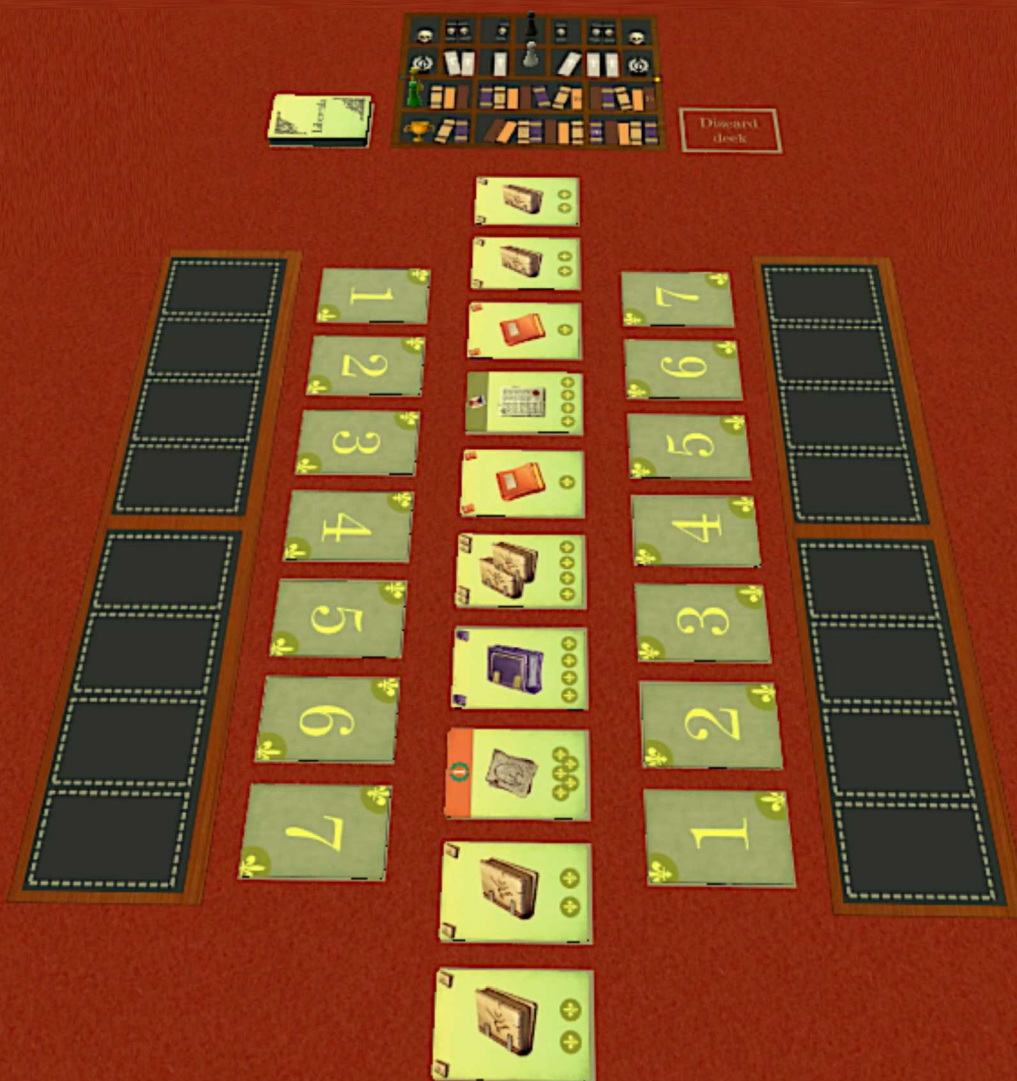

SELLING POINT: During his turn, each player selects one of the seven available Coin cards. Once used, the selected card is turned over, together with the opponent's coin card in a mirror position. By selecting our cards with higher spending capacity, we are indirectly favoring the opponent by eliminating his Coin cards with lower spending capacity.
